

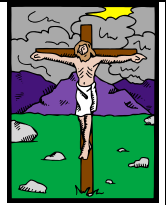

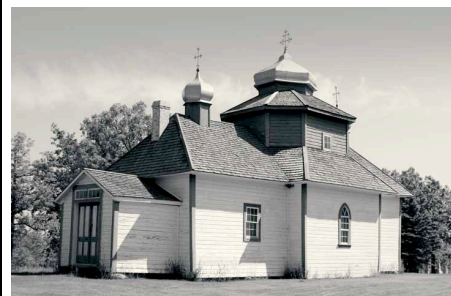

Session 6-The Crucifixion, Session 7-Christ the Victor.

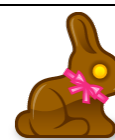
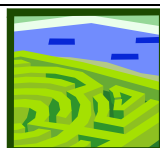


### Labyrinth
