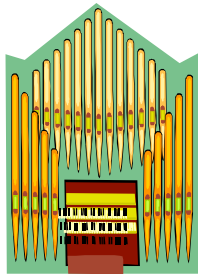

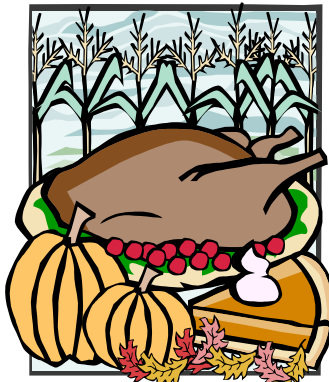


Admission \$15 at the door. This is a Benefit Concert for Third Avenue.
