Please sign the sheet on the bulletin board if you are interested in attending, so the board might plan for car pooling.

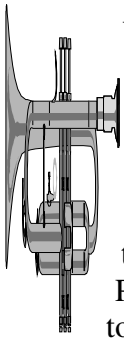
As a congregation we are asked to supply 2 dozen muffins and 3 dozen cookies.
