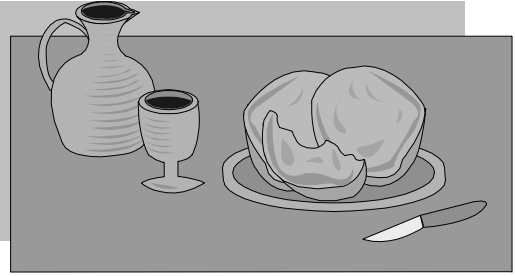


**Seder Supper

The formal foods needed for the meal:

- Haroset
- Parsley
- Boiled Eggs
- Horseradish
- Matzoh Bread
- Grape Juice
- Lamb

The rest of the menu is a pot-luck supper.

If you are able please bring, something from this list:

- Chicken with Matzah balls
- Small kosher egg noodles
- Vegetables
- Borscht (hot or cold)
- Chicken, fried, casserole, etc.
- Turkey
- Beef
- Roast lamb will be provided at Third Avenue

Dessert will be fresh fruit, bring some if you would like, as your donation to supper.

You will notice that pork and ham are not part of the supper menu, as at a Seder meal pork and/or ham would never be served.

Dessert is fresh fruit, as dairy products (milk, cheese, etc) are never served at the same meal or on the same dishes as meat meals.
